Equipment	Customer	Boats and paddles to be cleaned before session, Buoyancy Aid's to have been in quarantine for 72hrs. Customers should not share equipment unless they are from the same household. Boats and paddles to be cleaned after session.	8	2	16	Adequately Controlled

Capsize / Rescue	All	Customer encouraged to stand, walk or swim to the bank taking paddle and boat with them, if too small, ask family member to help. In a rescue situation, conscious kayaker to hold rear of instructor boat, not front. Taken to bank. Boat to be pushed to shore, family member to empty	8	2	16	Adequately Controlled
First Aid	All	Keep 2m distancing if possible, otherwise wash hands and wear gloves and mask, work from behind if possible, use family member and remotely administer.	9	2	18	Adequately Controlled
