2m Distancing	Customer	Where possible customers to maintain min 2m distance. Use lanes 1&5 to keep more than 2m apart. Except for family units, where distancing not a problem so all carts can be used.	8	2	16	Adequately Controlled
Equipment	Customer	Carts, steering wheels and break handles to be cleaned before session, Helmets to have been in quarantine for 72hrs. Customers should not share equipment unless they are from the same household. Carts, steering wheels and brakes to be cleaned between customers and at end of session.
