Fire	Participant	All participants under constant supervision by trained staff. Fire bucket to be on hand.	5	3	15	Adequately Controlled
Slips, trips, and falls	Everyone	Everyone is made aware of roots and overhanging branches in the area before entering. Groups to be made aware of guy lines from tarp systems.	3	3	9	Trivial Risk
Stings from nettles	Participant	Take the group to a location with minimal nettles, and indicate to the group what a nettle bush looks like and explain hazards.	2	4	8	Trivial Risk
